70 VOICES AND 3 TREES OF FREEDOM

Three "trees of freedom" will be created by some 500 pupils and apprentices. 70 groups of young people from Lower Normandy are in the process of gathering 70 sets of testimonies from those who lived through the D-Day Landings and the Battle of Normandy which includes veterans, members of the resistance and citizens of all nationalities. Extracts from eye witness accounts will be attached to these symbolic trees, which will be "planted" in May in three places emblematic of the Battle of Normandy.


